MINUTES

- I. The meeting was called to order at 1:00 by Board Chairperson David Alexander.
- II. Members present were; Chairman David Alexander, Mr. E. J. Hudson and Mrs. Cindy Bess. Also present was Mrs. P. Dixon-Director, Mrs. Lewis-Executive Director, and Mr. Dan Spata.

- IV. Informational Items: School Overview ~ Mrs. Dixon
 - > Summer School has started with 56 students enrolled. Summer School will go until June 29. STEM Program will start June 12 and end July 20.
 - > Enrollment for the upcoming school year is looking good especially for our Kindergarten classes.
 - Mrs. Dixon stated the plan for students with serious behavior issues is to get the parents in and discuss the important of the parent's involvement in the student's behavior plan.

- Mr. Spata stated May 2023 financial report showed a decrease because of the drop in enrollment. Our buses will be paid off by October.
- > The goal for 2023-2024 is to have at least 215 students enrolled
- Mr. Spata went over the 2023-2024 SY Budget. After reviewing the budget, the 2023-2024 SY Budget was Approved and Accepted. A motion was offer by Mr. Alexander and 2nd by Mr. Hudson.

Mrs. Lewis discussed getting a smaller bus to transport students to field trips and special activities. Mr. Spata stated financially we can afford this bus. A motion was Approved and Accepted to purchase this bus. A motion was offered by Mr. Alexander and 2nd by Mr. Hudson.

- > Mrs. Lewis discussed offering new program and extra curriculum activities for students in the upcoming school year by having extended school about 3 days a week.
- Mrs. Lewis also discussed asking the district to waive JHPA 5% Admin Fee that is taken out of our monthly FTE. A motion was Approved and Accepted to ask that the district waive the 5% Admin Fee. The motion was offered by Mr. Alexander and 2nd by Mrs. Cindy Bess.
